CATHETER OCCLUSION ORDERS Cathflo Activase- Instill into the occluded catheter. Let dwell for 30 minutes before attempting to aspirate. Dwell time not to exceed 120 minutes.

ANAPHYLAXIS ORDERS								
 MILD REACTION – Pruritis or rash, dizziness without blood pressure change, arthralgia, headache, nausea Stop Infusion and connect 5-10 ml syringe and draw back to a blood return to remove the existing drug in the line and discard. Flush line with 10 ml of 0.9% sodium chloride. Diphenhydramine IV:								
SEVERE REACTION/ANAPHYLAXIS- Urticaria, hypotension, chest pain, shortness of breath, stridor, wheezing, vomiting, severe abdominal or back pain. 1. Stop Infusion and connect 5-10 ml syringe and draw back to a blood return to remove existing drug in the line and discard. Flush line with 10ml of 0.9% sodium chloride. Call EMS 911. 2. Epinephrine IM Injection: (Do Not Delay Epinephrine in favor of other drugs/adjunctive therapies.) Epinephrine IM Injection: 0.15ml/ 0.15mg, 5 to 30 kg (Children, 33 to 66 lbs.) (Preferably thigh) Epinephrine IM Injection: 0.3 ml/0.3mg, >30 kg (patients weighing > 66 pounds) If there is no response or an inadequate response, a second Epinephrine dose may be administered at 5 to 15 minutes after initial injection. Intramuscular injection is given into the mid-outer thigh.
